

## **BASIC LIFE SUPPORT (BLS) CARD INFORMATION**

Bon Secours Mercy Health requires students to complete **BLS (Basic Life Support) Certification for Providers** to be in the clinical setting. BSMH recognizes three certifying bodies:

- 1. American Heart Association (AHA)
- 2. American Red Cross
- 3. American Safety and Health Institute (ASHI)

Bon Secours Health System **DOES NOT** accept CPR/AED/First Aid Community courses.


## **HeartCode BLS Certification Process**

## Step 1 – Purchase the BLS HeartCode module from the American Heart Association website

- i. Visit this link: <a href="https://elearning.heart.org/">https://elearning.heart.org/</a>
- ii. Click the chevron arrow next to "Courses" and select "Basic Life Support (BLS)"



iii. Click "purchase" on the "HeartCode BLS Online" package. On the next page, select "add to cart"



iv. Log in/create an account to check out

Step 2 – After you complete the online module portion, print your course completion certificate – you will need to take it with you to your skills check.

## Step 3 – Schedule your skills check portion.
