Joan Pollard Scholarship

The Joan Pollard Scholarship is a distinguished award aimed at supporting students who have demonstrated excellence and commitment in their studies and community involvement at SCHS.

Eligibility Criteria:

- 1. **Completion**: Applicants must have successfully completed two (2) semesters for RAD/DMS students or four (4) terms for NUR students within their program at SCHS.
- 2. **Community Service**: You must provide proof of completing two community service activities while enrolled at SCHS.
- 3. Essay Submission: An essay is required as part of your application.
- 4. Academic Performance: Your programmatic cumulative GPA will be considered.
- 5. **Recommendations**: Recommendations from your program director, faculty, and clinical preceptors will be considered.

Essay Specifications:

Your essay should be two pages, typed, and formatted according to APA guidelines. It must address the following:

- 1. **Knowledge Gained**: Describe the important knowledge you have acquired specific to your nursing, radiologic technology, or sonography program.
- 2. Clinical Experience: Discuss a clinical experience that allowed you to apply the knowledge gained from your program.
- 3. **Community Service**: Detail the community service projects you have participated in, how they relate to your profession, and what you learned from them.

Application Process:

- 1. **Essay Submission**: Please submit your essay according to the specifications outlined above.
- 2. **Proof of Community Service**: Provide documentation for the two community service activities you have completed.
- 3. **GPA Report**: Ensure your programmatic cumulative GPA is included in your application materials.
- 4. **Recommendations**: Obtain and include recommendations from your program director, faculty, and clinical preceptors.
